Award Description and Criteria

Award title: Saskatchewan Forage Industry Innovation Award

Purpose: Acknowledge exemplary innovation, leadership, service and stewardship in Saskatchewan's forage industry by producers, land managers, agency staff and researchers.

Selection Criteria

1. The primary requisite for this award is tangible evidence that the contribution of the nominee is note-worthy. Emphasis should be given to acknowledge the nominee's current recognized contribution(s) to the industry.
2. The qualifying reputation of the recipient must be regional or provincial in scope.
3. Both individuals and groups working as a team are eligible for the Award. Saskatchewan Forage Council membership is not required.
4. Qualifying contributions may be, but are not necessarily limited to: management practices, research, teaching, or public relations. Among those to be considered are farmers and ranchers, agency staff in land managing agencies, researchers, and technology transfer personnel who have contributed in a significant, prolonged and documented way to Saskatchewan's forage industry.

Award Presentation

1. One award can be presented annually, and will be presented at the Saskatchewan Forage Council annual meeting.
2. Each recipient of the Saskatchewan Forage Council Industry Innovation Award will receive a framed print or an otherwise appropriate memento and a citation.
